At the formation of this association on April 28, 2016, the constitution for The Small Business Association of British Columbia was adopted.

Bylaws

- 1. A quorum to conduct meetings is 6.
 - a. Directors can vote electronically. Electronic voting is a valid form of communication.
- 2. Eligibility for membership; the entity must be a business or commercial property owner (or representative) within the boundary.
- 3. Geographical boundary for membership runs;
 - a. N/S Fairfield Road to May Street
 - b. W/E Vancouver Street to Linden Street.
- 4. Associate membership; no provision. Applications considered on case by case basis by the board.
- 5. All expenditure discussed and approved by a motion.
- 6. Electronic voting is a valid form of decision-making for the group and board, with any action added to the next agenda for review.

Mandate

- a) As a group, we are the voice of business in the village with respect to all things that affect us.
- b) We promote the village as a commerce centre and undertake certain initiatives that will help perpetuate increases in our market share.
- c) Create and sustain dialogue with the City of Victoria and any other groups that may assist in the enhancement of our geographical boundary.
- d) Liaison with area residents to ensure all perspectives are considered when making fundamental changes to infrastructure.
